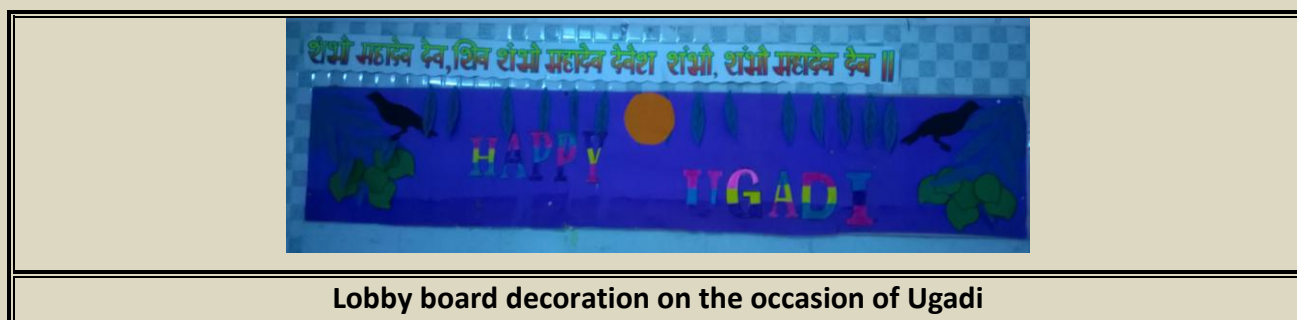
March- the month of colours, the advent of spring, the blooming of new flowers, the arrival of brighter mornings, and of course the month of exams- especially board exams !!!

us; but a lot of appreciation needs to be given to the teachers of this wing who take very special efforts and care to very patiently cater to the needs of each and every child of their class.

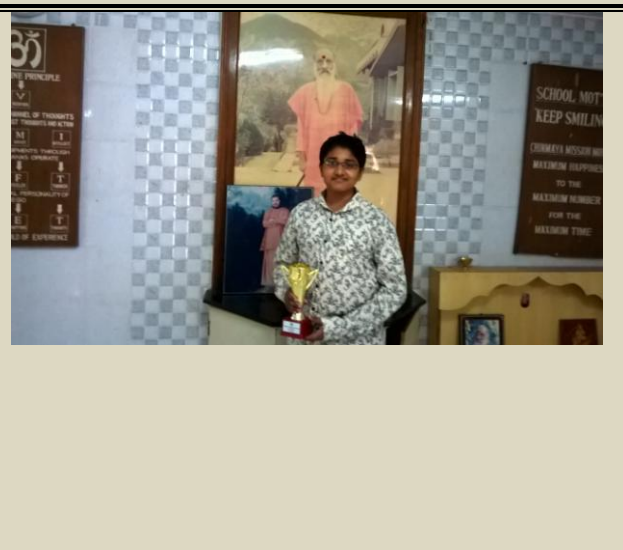
Other awards and Laurels:
